Itinerary

Day 1 – Arrive into Churchill, Town and Area Tour in the afternoon.

Wed. July 21 – Town & Area Tour



The perfect tour for those wanting a quick but thorough introduction to the community and its historical treasures. This tour includes popular sites such as: Cape Merry, Miss Piggy (plane crash site), the Polar Bear Jail, the Churchill Northern Studies Centre and of course we keep a lookout for wildlife the whole time

Thurs. July 22 – Zodiac Charter and Ithica Hike



The specially equipped, quiet Zodiacs leave the dock to greet the 3000 beluga whales that are entering the Churchill Estuary. Our guides have years of experience on the river and our boats have no moving parts that can harm the whales, giving you peace of mind when the belugas surround our boat.

Zodiac charter will be focused on looking for whales and Polar Bears we will also have a stop at the

Ancient Inuit tent ring sites and kayak resting spots in Button bay.

Next Enjoy a short Hike to the Nearly a century old Ithica Ship wreck. This WWI vessel has been ship wrecked 12 miles East of Churchill since 1960. Come experience her history and beauty during a short hike at low tide.



Fri. July 23 - Zodiac Charter and half day wildlife land tour



This tour is a favourite for many as you get an hour of interacting with our beautiful beluga whales and also see an important part of Canada's history at the Prince of Wales Fort.

Step inside to admire the strength of this stone structure that has been standing guard for 250 years at the mouth of the Churchill River. What used to be a bustling hub for

fur traders was later reinvented into a stone fortification when peace was threatened between England and France.
